POLICY RESOLUTION 2017-3**

REVISION TO RESOLUTION FOR RECREATIONAL MANAGEMENT

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Victoria Park Community Council, Inc., is charged with the responsibility to manage the association according to Article IV, Section 4.1 of the Declaration of Covenants, Contracts, and Restrictions of Victoria Park Community Council, Inc.

WHEREAS, there is a need to amend the policy pertaining to the Pool Rules of the Victoria Park amenities; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent that this rule shall be applicable to the current and future Board of Directors unless otherwise rescind, modified, or amended by a majority of the Board of Directors and shall supersede all other prior rules.

NOW THEREFORE, be it here resolved, the Board of Trustees has elected to authorize its managing agent to carry out the following policy pertaining to the Swimming Pools at the Victoria Park amenities centers.

Pool Rules

No Lifeguard on Duty – Swim at Your Own Risk

Pool Hours: Winter (Nov 1 – End of Feb) 7:30 am – 5:15 pm


Spring/Summer (Mar 1 – Aug 31) 6:15 am – 8:30 pm

Fall (Sep 1 – Oct) 6:45 am – 7:00 pm


- Shower before entering pool
- Infants and toddlers under the age of 4 must wear swim diapers
- In case of pool closure due to contamination, the pool and pool deck must be evacuated
- Proper bathing attire is required
- No running, profanity or horse play is allowed
- Smoking is not permitted in the facility
- Any child 13 and under MUST be accompanied by an adult at least 18 years of age at all times
- Food and beverage may not be consumed within 5 feet of the pool
- Keep pool area clean of debris and properly dispose of trash
- Guests must be accompanied by residents at all times (limit 2 guests per ID)
- All residents must have their photo ID card with them
- Battery powered radios only, No loud music
- No glass containers
- No commercial advertisements shall be posted or circulated
- Bathing load 142
- Pets (with the exception of service animals) are not permitted unless authorized by the Board
- No playing with safety equipment
- No diving
- In case of an emergency, DIAL 911

The Association is not responsible for any loss or damage to any private property or personal injury. Management reserves the right to deny access to the amenities to anyone.
