

Preserve Nature Trail

This winter the Victoria Gardens Men's Club worked hard in cooperation with Down to Earth and Servello and Sons Landscaping to re-clear the south half of the Victoria Park Preserve Nature trail, located in Victoria Gardens, and install new signage. The Victoria Gardens Men's Club members worked hard on this project and supplied labor, sign repair, and identification signs while the Victoria Park Community Council pitched in and provided allocated funds from the Community Enhancement fund for supplies. Down to Earth and Servello Landscaping assisted by providing mechanical clearing equipment and manpower at no cost and Shea Homes provided paint for trail markings and signs while Marg Goldsnider and Miller-Legg environmental consultants contributed technical help to develop a comprehensive trail map. Mulch was recycled from previously trimmed oak trees and recycled posts were provided for the signs. This great community project cost less than \$500. The Preserve Nature trail is a two mile trail system open to all Victoria Park residents and provides a fantastic opportunity to view wildlife in their natural habitat. Thank you to the Victoria Garden's Men's Club for spear heading this project and thank you to everyone who volunteered to make it a success.
