

Injured hawk on Orange Camp Rd this morning is okay! Just in case you were at the corner of Orange Camp Rd and 17-92 this morning around 8am, a juvenile red shouldered hawk was clipped by a car and flopping in the lanes. Lynn, Paul, and I went into action. We kept it safely on the bank's lawn for over an hour until FWC Officer Cameron arrived. He carefully swaddled the hawk so his wing was safe, and put him in a pet carrier. Then he drove the hawk to the BEST recovery place for birds and turtles, the Marine Science Center in Ponce Inlet. Animal Control does not treat injured wildlife.

Btw, our local rehabber is Tom Scotti, but he was in Ocala at the time.
