
MARCH NATURE WALK 9th ANNUAL BIRD COUNT SATURDAY, MARCH 21, 2020



Of the 60 species, 47 were found by the group during the 9AM to 12:30 PM Count. In the afternoon, John Serrao continued the count and found 11 additional species throughout Victoria Park: White Ibis, Cooper's Hawk, Least Sandpiper, Blue Jay, Purple Martin, House Wren, Eastern Bluebird, Prairie Warbler, Red-winged Blackbird, American Goldfinch, and House Finch (the last 3 species were present at a feeder in the Gardens).

Lynn Campbell also had Chipping Sparrows at her feeder that day and heard a Chuck-wills-Widow that morning, bringing the grand total to 60.
